Strawberry Shortcake Squares

One recipe made 30 2x2 inch molds of strawberry shortcake squares.*

John In Bibs': Strawberry Shortcake ep15

Ingredients:

Loaf of Angel Food Cake (mine came from Walmart)

Large container of Great Value Sliced Strawberries with sugar

1 Large container of Cool Whip



Directions:

- 1. Slice Angel Food Cake to ¼ inch thickness as uniformly as you can (I used a meat slicer) Cut to size to fit each 2x2 mold (Or use dividers and layer on your lined tray)
- 2. Puree strawberries in blender
- 3. Pour just enough pureed strawberries to cover the angel food cake in each mold.Fill the molds 3/4 of the way with Cool Whip.
- 4. Top with another thinly sliced piece of Angel Food Cake.
- 5. Add a hint of strawberry puree using a spoon, on top of Angel Food Cake.
- 6. Add a dollop of Cool Whip on top of each Shortcake. (Add your dividers here if using)
- 7. Freeze until solid.
- 8. Pop out of molds and place on a lined tray. No need to remove dividers if used)
- 9. Freeze Dry

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10. Store Appropriately (See Tips and Tricks for storage help

Cycle Time: My cycle time was shy of 28 hours in a medium freeze dryer.	Rehydration: Not intended
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Cycle times & rehydration for reference only
Medium = 6 Cups/Tray
Small = 4 Cups/Tray

* Large Tray = 8 Cups/tray
